- **Voting on Election Day:** Polling places are open on **Tuesday, August 4, 2026** and polling hours vary by county. You can look up your polling location and its hours using this link [:https://mVIC.sos.state.mi.us/Voter/index](https://mVIC.sos.state.mi.us/Voter/index)
- **In-person early voting** is available through **Saturday, July 25th- Sunday, August 2nd.**
- **Voting by mail:** You do not need an excuse to vote early by mail and can request an early mail ballot either online or by mail through **July 31, 2026**, or in person at your Board of Elections office through **August 3, 2026.**
- **Voter Registration:** You can register and update your voting address online or by mail through **Monday, July 20th.**
